From the Pastor's Desk

*Do you not know that a little yeast leavens all the dough?
Clear out the old yeast, so that you may become a fresh batch of dough,
In as much as you are unleavened. For our paschal lamb, Christ, has been sacrificed. Therefore, let us
celebrate the feast, not with the old yeast but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.*

I think that this scripture for Easter morning which speaks of the yeast that leavens all the “dough” is very appropriate for our Easter Appeal ☺ And it’s not just the obvious connection between our request for financial contributions and the equation of “dough” with “money”. What’s really important is the “leaven” you are for the life of the parish. Because of your generosity so many people are nourished with the “bread of life”. I’m speaking not only of the Eucharist but also of the many ways in which people are nourished and grow in faith, hope and love through the parish and its ministries. The Official Vatican prayer book for the Jubilee Year 2000, *Pilgrim Prayers*, includes a Via Lucis along with the traditional Via Crucis.

Similar to the Via Crucis (Stations of the Cross) and the four passion narratives, the Via Lucis (Stations of Light) reflects upon the final chapters of each of the four gospels, which narrate the appearances of the Risen Lord from Easter to Pentecost.

We hope that the 14 "Stations of Light" will help Xavier community and friends walk boldly into the light with the Risen Christ!
