



## For Couples Who Plan to be Married Elsewhere

For a couple, **where at least one member is a registered member of St. Francis Xavier parish or who lives within the parish boundaries**, we will be happy to do the preparation (paperwork) that is required for the wedding, provided sufficient time is allowed for that preparation, usually six months.

Because of the time and postage required both here and at the Archdiocesan offices, we ask for \$250.00 for this service.

- In addition, if a dispensation is required, we ask for an additional \$50.00.
- And if the mailing must be done internationally, the Archdiocese asks an additional \$150.00.

When all the materials are gathered, they will be sent to the New York Archdiocese and then to the Diocese in which the wedding will take place. Then that diocese will send the materials to the church of the wedding. A letter of permission to be married elsewhere will be included in the wedding materials. All this requires that the materials be gathered at the latest one month before the wedding date.

If neither party is a registered member of St. Francis Xavier, and does not live within the parish boundaries, it might be possible to gather the required materials here. This will require a letter of permission from your own parish to be included. You might also register here if you do so 6 months before your wedding.

**I ask that the following procedure be followed.** This cannot be done any more on an individual basis. Also, you will need to consult the priest who will officiate at your wedding as well. Therefore what needs to be done here can easily be done in a larger group setting.

Below I give the dates for these group settings. Please plan your own schedule so as to follow these dates so that we may prepare the materials properly. **I will not be able to depart from these dates.** The time for Session I is 6:30 pm to 7:30 pm, or until finished. The time for Session II is 6:00 pm.

### **Session I:** Fact finding session

- A brief preliminary prayer
  - ... Assumption 1: at least one of you must be a baptized Catholic
  - ... Assumption 2: you are free to be married in the Church
  - ... if needed, a word about annulments
- A business piece
  - ... Fill out the required information sheet.
  - ... Please be prepared to present the required fee(s):
    - = \$250.00 for the service provided by the church
    - = An additional \$50.00 fee if a dispensation is involved
    - = A further \$150.00 for international mailing.
- More than paperwork
  - ... The human requirements of marriage: friendship and honesty
  - ... The spiritual hopes for marriage: holiness and sacrament.
  - ... Distribute texts for the wedding
- Now, things that are required:
  - ... recent baptismal certificates (6 months)
  - ... programs for pre-Cana
  - ... pre-Nuptial Investigation
  - ... freedom to marry witnesses
  - ... dispensation if needed (explain the permission and dispensation)
  - ... letter from the parish to the church of the wedding
  - ... Any further requirements from the church or diocese of the wedding
- A note on obtaining the Marriage License

- Time to complete the pre-Nuptial investigation

**Session II:** Preparing the folder to be sent.

- A brief preliminary prayer
- Gathering all required materials
- Walking through the Marriage ritual (if needed)
- Look at selected *check lists*
- Assurance that the presiding priest has been consulted
- Prepare the letter of permission from SFX
- a spiritual journey ahead.

Beginning June 12<sup>th</sup> 2014 the schedule of sessions is as follows; Session I (Things Required) begins at 6:30 pm. On the same evening, but beginning at 6:00 pm, Session II (Sending Materials) will take place. For those seeking Session II, please make sure everything required is in order.
