## *From the Pastor's Desk*

Dear Parishioners,

I'm writing this letter to you while I'm on retreat at Eastern Point, Gloucester Mass. By the time you will be reading this, however, I will have returned to Xavier after a few weeks of vacation and retreat. I am grateful to God and to the parish for the "time away" so that I can serve you with a renewed energy and commitment.

Gonzaga Retreat House has been a very special place of encounter with God throughout my Jesuit life. I began making retreats here in the 1970's. I made the 30 day Spiritual Exercises in 1983 and have returned almost every year since for my annual 8 day retreat. (except for the past three years ago when the retreat house closed for necessary renovations.) In the "new wing" of the retreat house almost all of the rooms look out over the ocean. There is so much beauty that surrounds you! I was especially aware of this on August 6th, the feast of the Transfiguration. That day it was as if creation itself were transfigured! The beauty and clarity of light from the sunrise, the sunlight glistening on the water throughout the day, with the brilliant blue sky dappled with clouds until the full moon that night, all created a sense of the "World being charged with the grandeur of God". As I contemplated the breathtaking beauty of that day, I thought of the poem of Gerard Manley Hopkins that I just quoted. I remembered as well a piece of choreography I had done to the Benjamin Britten setting of the poem. I also remembered another poem of Hopkins that Britten set to music and that I choreographed. It is *Deus Ego Te Amo*. (O God, I love you!) This prayer is attributed to Saint Francis Xavier and as pastor of Xavier Parish it has even more meaning for me than it did when I first heard it. I'd like to share it with you now.

*O God, I love thee, I love thee —  
Not out of hope of heaven for me  
Nor fearing not to love and be  
In the everlasting burning.  
Thou, thou, my Jesus, after me  
Didst reach thine arms out dying,  
For my sake sufferedst nails and lance,  
Mocked and marred countenance,  
Sorrows passing number,  
Sweat and care and cumber,  
Yea and death, and this for me,  
And thou couldst see me sinning:  
Then I, why should not I love thee,  
Jesu so much in love with me?  
Not for heaven's sake; not to be  
Out of hell by loving thee;  
Not for any gains I see;  
But just the way that thou didst me  
I do love and I will love thee:  
What must I love thee, Lord, for then? —  
For being my king and God. Amen.*

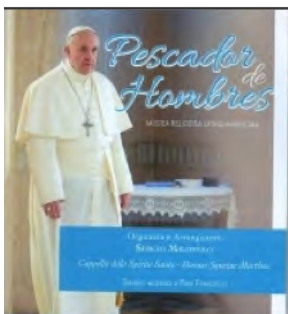

## REGISTRATION

All families coming for Religious Education for the first time need to be registered in the Parish before enrolling in the Religious Education Program.

Please bring the following required documents when coming to register:

- a) A copy of your child's Baptismal Certificate.
- b) A statement (transcript) of all prior Religious Education if the student is beyond first grade.
- c) First Holy Communion, if the sacrament has already been received.
- d) Registration fees in a check payable to the Church of St. Francis Xavier or through Faith Direct. To pay through Faith Direct please visit <https://membership.faithdirect.net/events/details/946>.

Families currently attending our program need to be re-registered. Please bring the Registration fees in a check payable to the Church of St. Francis Xavier when coming to re-register.

**Registration/Re-registration will take place on Sunday August 13, 20 and 27 from 10:30 am to 11:30 am in the West Room.**

Tuition for the 2017-2018 school year is \$100 per student, which includes the textbook, supplies, additional instructional materials, catechists' and catechist assistants' stipend. There is also a \$50 Sacramental Fee for children preparing for First Holy Communion (2<sup>nd</sup> grade) and Confirmation (7<sup>th</sup> grade) to contribute to Bishop's stipend and Pottery retreat cost. Snacks fee is \$80 per family.
