  - Currently at approx. 816 attendees (686 adults, 130 youth) vs. 1,200-1,300 pre-COVID
  - 40 daily mass attendees
  - o 28-30 weddings
  - o 113 baptisms
  - o 20 First Communions
  - 19 Confirmations

  - o 110 Family Faith
  - o 79 Lectors
  - 73 Eucharistic Ministers
  - 16 RCIA
- **Lighting**: formal proposal submitted for completion in early 2024; renovate current lighting board and assess possibility of adding LED lighting
- Provincial Office visit: Fr. Jim Casciotti visited the parish to observe activities and meet with various staff
