



Procession of Palms:




- Vs. 1: Other spirits, lesser gods, have courted me with lies. Here among you I have found a truth which bids me rise.

Psalm 22 My God, Why Have You Abandoned Me?





- Vs. 4: I will praise you to my people, and proclaim you in their midst, O fear the Lord, my people, give glory to God's name.


