Amazing Grace! How sweet the sound, that saved a soul like me! I once was lost, but now am found, was blind but now I see.


'Twas grace that taught my heart to fear, and grace my fears relieved; How precious did that grace appear the hour I first believed.

Through many dangers, toils, and snares, I have already come; 'Tis grace has brought me safe thus far, and grace will bring me home.


When we've been there ten thousand years, bright shining as the sun, We've no less days to sing God's praise than when we'd first begun.





Lamb of God




