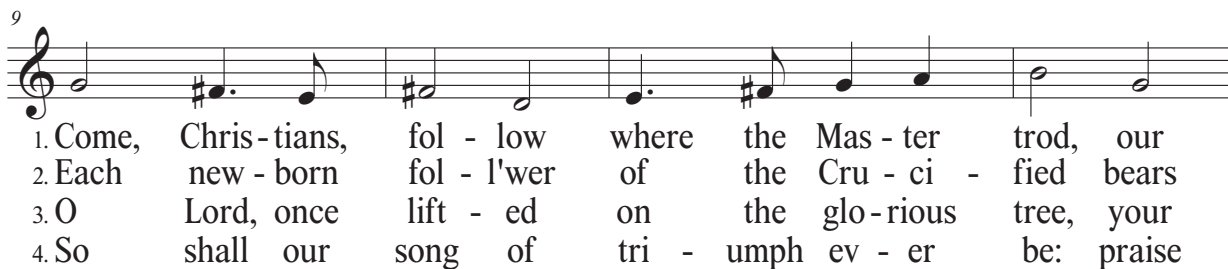
### **Church of St. Francis Xavier Pledge for Racial Justice**
