



O come, O Dayspring from on high and cheer us by your drawing nigh; Disperse the gloomy clouds of night, and death's dark shadow put to flight. **REF**


O come, Desire of nations, bind In one the hearts of humankind; O bid our sad divisions cease, And be for use our King of Peace. **REF**
