1. OPENING PRAYER: led by Belinda Conway

2. PASTOR'S REPORT

- a. **Fr. James Casciotti,** Assistant Provincial for Pastoral Ministries, visited SFX prior to the Provincial's visit that is planned in January. Fr. Casciotti is responsible for pastoral planning and assessing how parish communities are being served and resources are being deployed. He met with various parish leaders during his visit.
- b. **The Archdiocese** is consolidating parishes, is selling the building where the administrative offices are located, and is transferring some of the archdiocesan ministries to individual parishes.

3. PASTORAL COUNCIL PRIORITIES

a. Parish Communications:

- Prayers for sick and deceased parishioners will be published in the bulletin for 3 weeks, then names will be removed.
- Several ministries are using What's App for intra-ministry communications.
- The Communications Committee will meet in January to discuss improvements to the bulletin and website. Yago suggested reviewing the SFX privacy policy at that time.
- o "How to Host an Event" will be reviewed/revised.
- b. **Affinity groups** based on age, zip code, alumni, etc. will be considered after census analysis.
- c. **Livestream Community:** determination will be made if a formal group is needed based on review of live stream data.
- d. Welcome Cards in pews: to be reviewed and revised by Jacob.

e. **Review of PC Accomplishment List,** similar to an annual report, might be helpful to parishioner discernment about joining the PC. Testimonials from current PC members would also be helpful.

4. SYNODAL PARISH UPDATES:

- Fr. Jim Martin, who attended the Synod meetings at the Vatican in 2023 and 2024, has asked to meet with parishioners at SFX to discuss the synod report and determine how we can build on the synodal work already in progress.
- o Fr. Martin will visit SFX on **January 26th at 1PM**. His visit will be live-streamed.
- The **Synod Committee** is meeting on December 17th and will work closely with representatives of the Pastoral Council (PC) to plan the Ministry Retreat on February 8, 2025.

c. Migrant Ministry:

- A new migrant ministry is being organized. SFX will be participate in two visits to the border in January and February.
